



**TWO INSTITUTIONAL BEST PRACTICES OF GOVERNMENT POST GRADUATE NOIDA,

PRACTICE 1:

PROMOTING ACTIVITIES RELATED TO ALL ROUND DEVELOPMENT OF GIRLS STUDENT.

Objective of the practice:

Government Post Graduate college Noida is the only Government College of higher learning with

coeducational structure. The college has the girls-boys ratio of 70:30 respectively. Hence girls outnumber boys, thus the institution claims the status of a educational centre which attracts more and more female students. True to its mission and best practice, the college exhibits its effort in the following ways:






- 2.Under the 'Mission Shakti' Programme, students were given online training on self defence.
- 3.Webinar was organized on the topic -Gender equality-Challenge for Mainstream Politics."4. Neuro Physio Therapist, Dr, Pawan Khatana delivered online invited lecture to girls on the topic- "Role of Exercise on Emotional and Mental Wellbeing for Re Framing Empowerment Among Women In Current Scenario."
5. Students participated in E poster competition on 'Problem of Mal Nutrition in Women and a webinar on Positive Parenting was also organized.

Above are few activities being mentioned from the series of the activities which were conducted during lockdown and maintenance of Covid Protocols. It is also necessary to mention that, though these above-mentioned programmes were women oriented, nevertheless boys also participated in these various programmes.

Problem Encountered and Resource Required:

In this session not only the students but also the college administration encountered in implementing various programmes at institutional level and assessing level of success. The college found hard in convincing student for any field work during the pandemic. The resource which were required were related to ensure effectiveness of programme was high speed internet and availability of smart phones/laptop/desktop with each and every student as many of the students could use these resources when their parents were not using.

PRACTICE 2: INCREASED PARTICIPATORY LEARNING AND STUDENT SUPPORT



Objective of the practice:

The students of Government Post Graduate College are from different Socio-Economic groups; hence the college promotes an environment for the students in which they are able to showcase their talent. The college aims at grooming its students in a manner that they can accept and face the challenges, shedding off their inhibitions and building a personality which can adapt in the competitive world. Students are predominantly from rural pockets of Noida city and are largely from lower income group. The faculty members of the college try and incorporate the new pedagogic tools for learning, so that students are introduced to these tools and also encouraged to make use of these tools.

Context:

The context of the practice is evident from the nature of the college and the students, who are its members. Government of the state of Uttar Pradesh has a vision of providing best facilities to the Government Institutions of the state, in this regard grants, aid and budget is allocated to government colleges for better infrastructural development and modernization of colleges. In this regard MHRD -RUSA grant has also been used. Keeping with the spirit of

Governmental agencies to upgrade and modernize infrastructural facilities, college not only focus on its implementation but encourages students to be equal participant, along with the faculty to use the enhanced tools.

Evidence of Success:

1. There are smart classes, Rooms with interactive boards, projectors, ICT enabled classrooms etc.
2. Computer lab is also there, which is used by students when the college is opened for offline learning.
3. Students were encouraged to make PPT presentations, participate in debates, speech, quiz
4. Students organize various activities like rallies on awareness programmes, posters, slogans etc.
5. During the time of COVID students did all these activities through digital mode and showed that nothing hampered them to showcase their talent.
6. Botany department with the help of students did partial green audit of the campus and on their initiative, they tried to revive botany department plants whenever college opened for offline activities for students.
7. Students distributed mask, covid kits whenever required. They also encouraged and motivated their fellow students, parents and neighbours to get vaccinated and install Arogya Setu camp.

Problem Encountered and Resource Required:

This session has gone through covid phase which hampered regular college activities. Though the college was off most of the time for students for offline activities, however much of students' participation was ensured through online activities with few offline tasks. This all could not deliver much expected result and students were also facing many challenges to complete the task as family members, relatives and they themselves were facing corona wrath. Faculty members also suffered the same. This all created problem for the members of the college to successfully accomplish many tasks, though the required resources were there.
