Best Practice I

1. Awareness drives and Sensitization of Students about relevant issues.



Objective of the practice:

Government Post Graduate College is a Co-educational Institution located in the heart of the city. Students of this college are mainly from the rural pockets of the city, living in close sheltered family and neighbourhood, which makes them often unaware or ignorant about many relevant issues, therefore as a youth and as a citizen it becomes imperative that they are sensitized about the important issues/problems, so that they can shape the future of the country in positive direction.

Context:

The context of this practice is to effectively carry out awareness drives and sensitization programmes. College all the year round organizes various awareness programmes according to the academic calendar, as well as schedule sent by the Higher Education Department. The college engages itself in these activities with full vigour. Invited Lectures, speech, posters, rallies etc were organized. Students voiced their messages related to sensitive issues and also educated their peer groups and class mates about gender issues, tobacco use, voting rights, constitutional rights and duties, rich cultural Heritage of NE India, etc.

Evidence of Success:

The Government Post Graduate College, true to its nature and spirit has conducted massive awareness programmes related to varied topics. The evidence of success can be witnessed by the number of students participating enthusiastically in these events. The series of evidence of these programmes are:

- Women Cell and Mission Shakti Cell of the college organized 'Psychological and Educational Counseling on 'Break the Silence and Speak Openly' - sensitize students on issues of sexual harassment.
- Essay Competition was organized on Women Equality.
- National Girl Child safety day was observed so that students of both gender can be sensitized.
- Role & Contribution of Women in Creating Progressive Family- on this theme lecture was organized.

- Drive against tobacco use- a massive cycle rally, street play, slogans etc. activities were organized, in which students did the play near City Centre Metro Station.
- Economically Weaker Section and Disability Support Cell, Eco Restoration Club together distributed warm winter clothes and other requirements to the needy persons.
- Road Safety Day was observed with series of activities were organized and a big 'Human Chain' was made by the Staff and the students of the College.
- Students participated in various activities organized by 'Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat'. Students learnt about the art, culture and language of Meghalaya.
- Constitutional Day was also celebrated and students were made aware about their Fundamental Rights and Duties.

Problem Encountered and Resource Required:

Students are constantly motivated to participate in these activities. However, when there are too many programmes being organized, students get exhausted and sometimes it becomes difficult to bring them on the dice. The college administration tries to felicitate outstanding performances and the contribution of the students in acknowledged, but sometimes it is witnessed that few students, in spite of their engagement in their studies and home, cannot be well rewarded as college has limited financial resource to spend on students. Since the college has students from the rural pockets or are from conservative background, hence participation of students beyond certain limits of time and place becomes difficult.

- **Four students participated in Cultural/Literary District level Zila Yuva Utsav, Dadri and received prizes in all categories.**
- **Three students participated in Cultural/Literary University level and secured first and second positions.**
- **Two students participated in Cultural/Literary/Sports and National level.**
- **Five students participated in State level Sports competition and won gold, silver, bronze medal.**
- **Three students participated in district level sports competition won gold, silver, bronze medal.**
- **Seven students participated in Inter Collegiate Sports Competition and won gold, silver, bronze medals.**

These are some of the activities in which students participated and held positions in almost all the categories.

Problem Encountered and Resource Required:

Administration of Government Post Graduate College Noida makes every effort to provide facilities and support to students, so that they can participate in various activities which are organized outside college by external bodies.
